The following changes were made in locomotive assignment during the month:

Lake Superior Division Class "B" Locomotive No. 653 is eliminated from assignment list account being authorized for dismantling.

Fargo Division Locomotive No. 243 was transferred to Idaho Division for service on Camas Prairie RR, and Idaho Division Locomotive No. 244 was released from service on that line to be stored unserviceable at Parkwater.

Rocky Mountain Division Locomotives No. 1529 and 1648 were transferred from Rocky Mountain to ~~Idaho~~^{Tacoma} Division, account no longer needed on Park Branch, both being oil burners.

Rocky Mountain Division Locomotives Nos. 2602 and 2603 were converted from coal to oil burners at South Tacoma Shop, and transferred to Tacoma Division for service.
