DISTRIBUTION OF POWER - DECEMBER 1, 1941

The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month:

Lake Superior Division Locomotive No. 1030, which was transferred to St. Paul Division and leased American Crystal Sugar Company at East Grand Forks, was released by that Company and returned to Lake Superior Division at Brainerd.

Saint Paul Division Locomotives Nos. 2661, 2663 and 2664, were transferred to Fargo Division and Saint Paul Division Locomotive No. 2667 to Rocky Mountain Division.

Saint Paul Division Locomotive No. 1797, which was reported transferred to Tacoma Division last month, was stopped at Livingston and assigned to Rocky Mountain Division.

Rocky Mountain Division Locomotive No. 5113 was transferred to Idaho Division.

New A-4 Locomotive, No. 2676 was received from the builders and assigned to Saint Paul Division.

New Z-7 Locomotives Nos. 5121, 5122, 5123, and 5124 were received from the builders and assigned to Rocky Mountain Division.

Total number locomotives assigned 834.
