

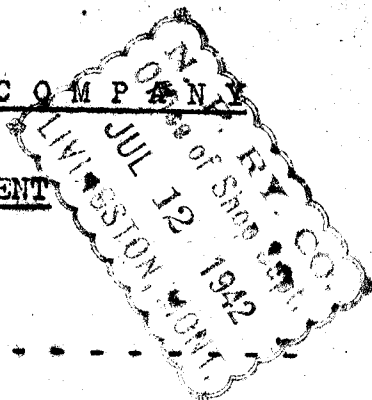

The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month:

Idaho Division locomotive No. 1529, which was leased Camas Prairie R.R., was returned and Locomotive 1630 furnished in lieu thereof.

Idaho Division locomotive No. 1639 was equipped with mechanical stoker while in Livingston Shop.

Tacoma Division locomotive No. 1122, which was leased King Street Terminal, was returned and Locomotive 1132 furnished in lieu thereof.

Tacoma Division locomotive No. 1081, which was leased to the Government at Fort Lewis, was returned and Locomotive 1092 furnished in lieu thereof.
