The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month of July:

Lake Superior Division locomotive No. 2459 was transferred to Fargo Division.

Yellowstone Division locomotive No. 2180 was transferred to Fargo Division.

Idaho Division locomotives Nos. 1126 and 1127 were transferred to Tacoma Division.

Tacoma Division locomotive No. 1357 was transferred to Idaho Division and leased Camas Prairie RR.

Tacoma Division Diesel-Electric road switch locomotive No. 155 was transferred to Idaho Division and assigned to passenger service on Palouse and Lewiston Branch.

New Diesel-Electric switch locomotive No. 98, which was received and assigned Rocky Mountain Division, was transferred to Tacoma Division at South Tacoma

Great Northern locomotives Nos. 3131 and 3133, which were leased and assigned Tacoma Division, were returned to that Company.
