The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month of March:

Saint Paul Division locomotive No. 2253 was transferred to Lake Superior Division.

Saint Paul Division locomotives Nos. 1504, 1646 and Fargo Division Locomotives Nos. 1686, 1800 were leased to the Canadian National Ry.

Rocky Mountain Division locomotives Nos. 2660 and 4007 were transferred to the Saint Paul and Fargo Divisions, respectively.

Tacoma Division locomotives Nos. 1368, 1670, 1675, 1910, and 2605, were converted from coal to oil burners.
