This has been looked over on the ground by Division Engineer and Division Superintendent and it is their joint recommendation that the work be done.



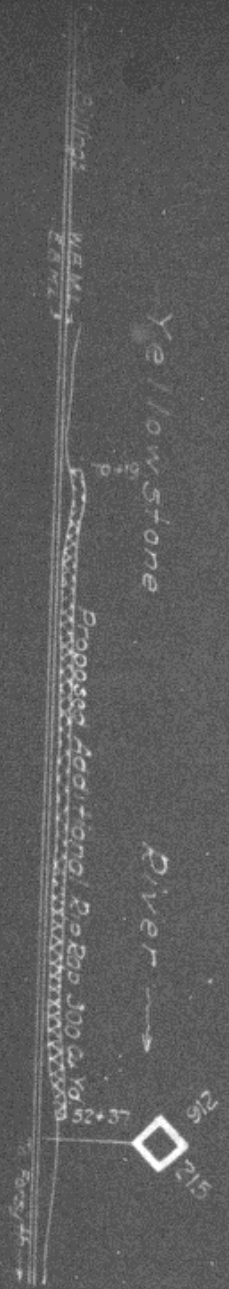
Work should be commenced at once in order to complete by as soon as possible and be done by company force under charge of Division Superintendent
