Location: Saint Cloud, Minnesota.

Title installation of electric lights in reformatory depot. (G.N. Property)

Reason: There were no facilities for lighting the reformatory station platform just east of St. Cloud, Minnesota.

The authorities of the Minnesota State Reformatory School, located near the station, had requested that a light be installed at the station to safeguard passengers leaving the train at that point during the night and agreed to furnish the current free of charge.

The telegraph lineman at St. Cloud was requested to ascertain what material would be necessary to install a light and obtain the electric current from the State Reformatory Power Line which passes near the station. Investigation by the lineman revealed that only two hundred feet of wire would be required and as sufficient material was at hand, he proceeded to install the light with the assumption that it was unnecessary for further instructions.

The electric light is now in use and this authority is requested in order to correct the records and take care of the accounting properly.

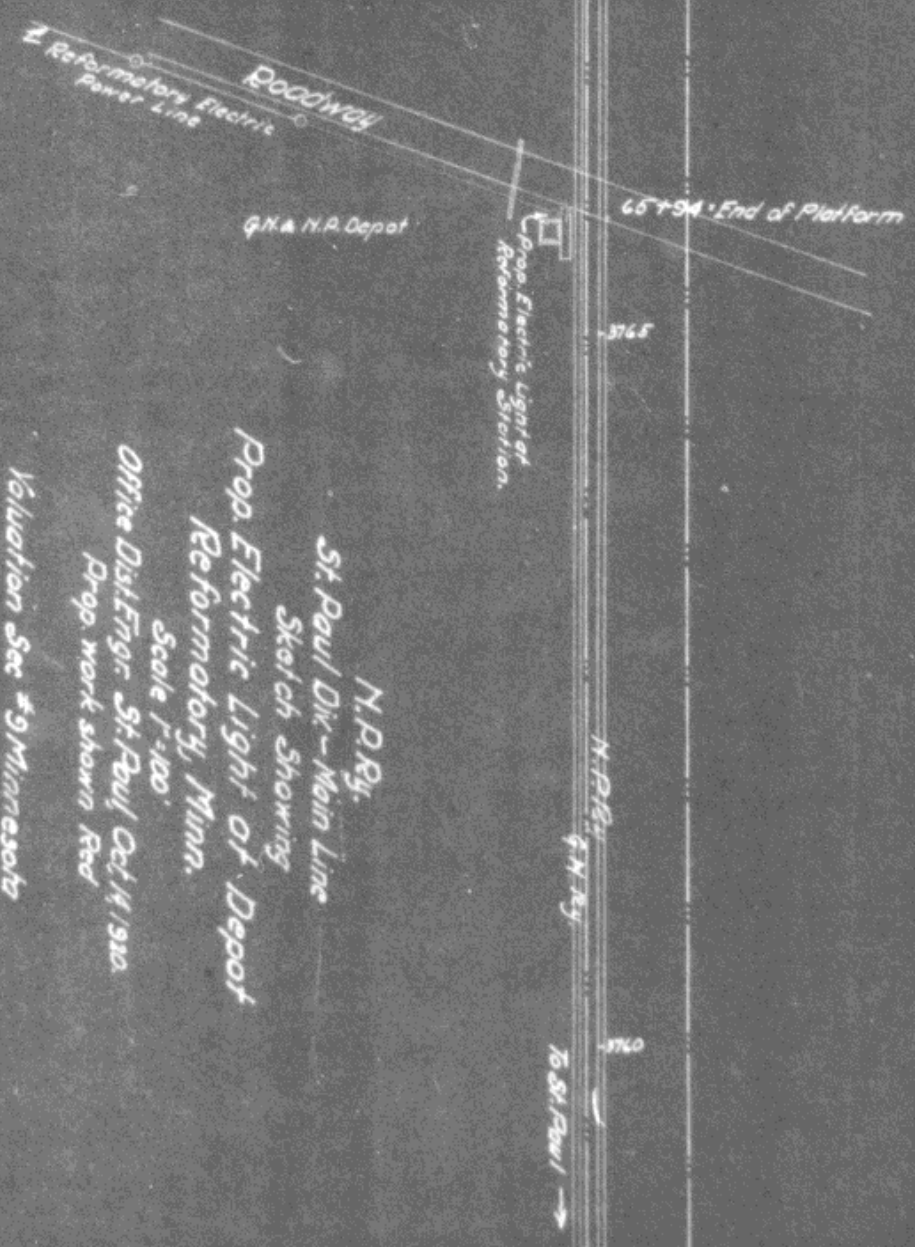
