We are using four 9 1/2" Westinghouse air pumps (with one additional pump temporarily installed as an auxiliary) for furnishing compressed air at Dickinson Roundhouse.

There has been released, by the Engineering Department, a 10 1/2" cross compound air compressor used on the Spokane grade separation.

It is recommended that the 10 1/2" compressor be installed at Dickinson in place of three of the 9 1/2" pumps. This arrangement will provide about 30' more air per minute with a smaller consumption of steam.
