Title and Reason: Sale of "Shadinger Farm" to M.S. Kelly under five year contract dated October 1, 1921.

This land, including improvements, was purchased in 1907 at a cost of \$14,500.00 to settle a suit brought by J. N. Shadinger against the Railway Company for damages on account of said land being overflowed as a result of the Railway Company filling in its trestle extending south from the Snohomish River. This settlement was made on advice of the Legal Department as it was expected that claims for damages would be made at each succeeding period of high water and the purchase of the property was the only method by which these claims could be permanently settled.

The sale to Mr. Kelly is made subject to the Railway Company's right to overflow the land, which accounts for the low selling price as compared with the original cost of the land.
