Title: **Heavy repairs and partial replacement of the joint Northern Pacific-Western Union telegraph pole line between Butte and Silver Bow, also replacing No. 8 Iron Wire through Butte Yards.**

This line was last reconstructed in 1900 of Class "B" Eastern Cedar poles. A recent inspection by representatives of the Railway Company and Telegraph Company indicated that approximately 35% of the poles are defective and need repairs or replacement and that approximately 31 miles of wire (iron) require replacement because of deterioration.

It was agreed by representatives of the two companies that the work would consist of replacement of defective material in its present location. New poles to be class "B" Western Cedar, tank treated. The defective iron wire to be renewed with No. 8 SWG iron wire.
