Title and Reason: Proposed 100 gal. gasoline tank for sectionmen, plan No. 199.

At the present time gasoline to serve section foreman's motor car at Lynch Spur is taken care of in galvanized tanks. These tanks are very unsatisfactory as they often spring leaks and more or less gasoline is wasted.

Therefore, for economical purposes a 100 gallon gasoline tank with pump as per standard plan 184 should be furnished at this point in order to conserve gasoline and eliminate the dangerous fire hazard.

Work has been looked over upon the ground by Division Superintendent and District Engineer and it is their joint recommendation that same be approved.

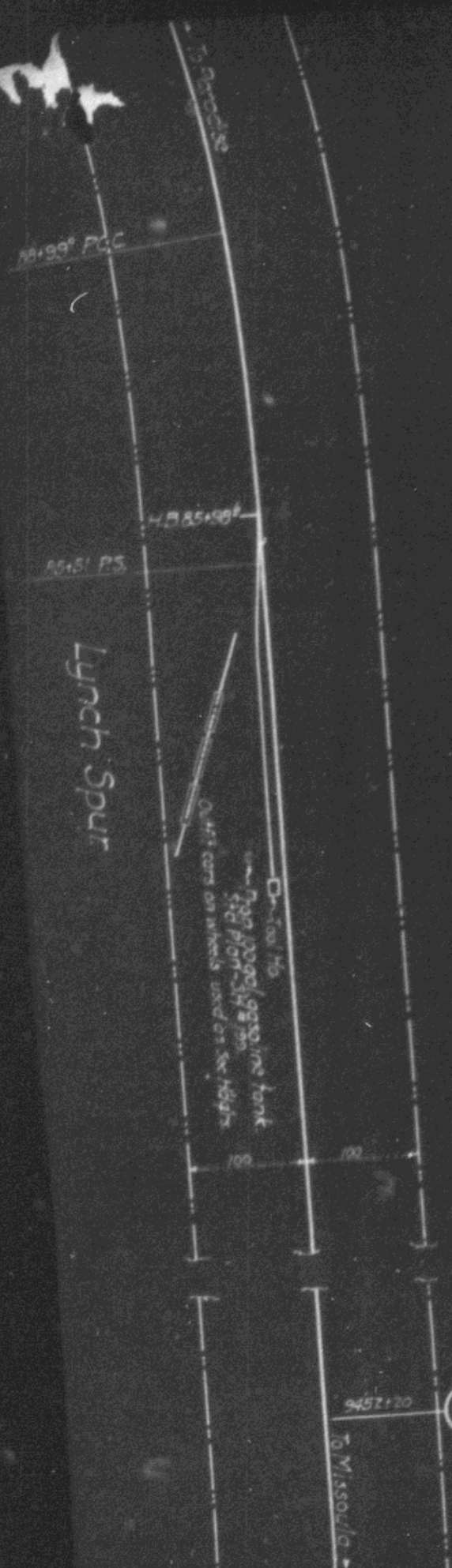
