Title and Reason: **Illuminated Crossing Signs.**

The principal highway at Toston crosses the Railway Company's tracks just west of the depot. This is the main highway through this country and crosses the Missouri River at this point, this being the only crossing on the Missouri River for many miles. The County Commissioners of Broadwater County petitioned the Railroad Commission for an automatic crossing alarm and in investigating the matter it was decided that an illuminating sign should be placed similar to those placed at Perma and Noxon, in Sanders County, Montana. The General Superintendent answered the Railroad Commission to this effect and this AFE is submitted to cover installation of illuminated crossing signs at this point.

Work looked over on ground by District Engineer and Division Superintendent and it is their recommendation that work be done.
