Location: Parkwater, Wash.

Title and Reason: Disposition of temporary strike camp buildings.

To take care of the strike camp emergency last year, we constructed at Parkwater terminals for housing new employes:

- 3 double bunk houses 40 x 82'
- 1 double bunk house 20 x 82'
- 1 mess house 40 x 122'
- 1 guard office & wash room 16 x 24'
- 1 coal shed 6 x 40'
- 1 water closet 8 x 19'

It is recommended that two of the larger bunk houses and the small double bunk house be moved and placed opposite the Parkwater car shops, as shown on the attached print, these buildings then to be used as a paint shop and for storing car material.

The third large double bunk house should be moved to the material yard, as recommended by the General Storekeeper, for the storage of B&B lumber and cement.

There being no need at the present time for the other buildings, that is, the mess house, guard office, coal shed and water closet, it is recommended that these be left at their present location for the present until such time that they may be needed. (Over)

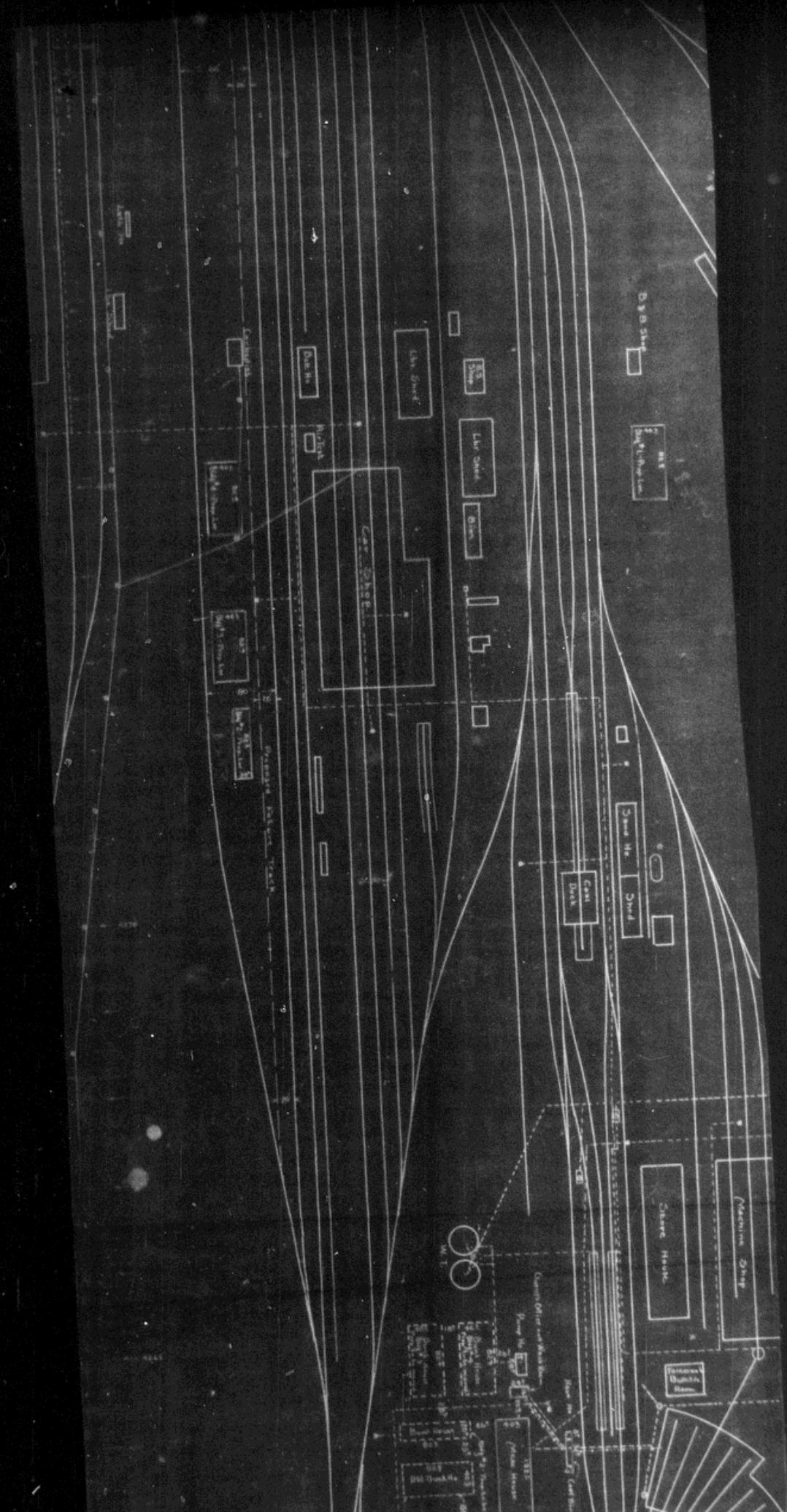


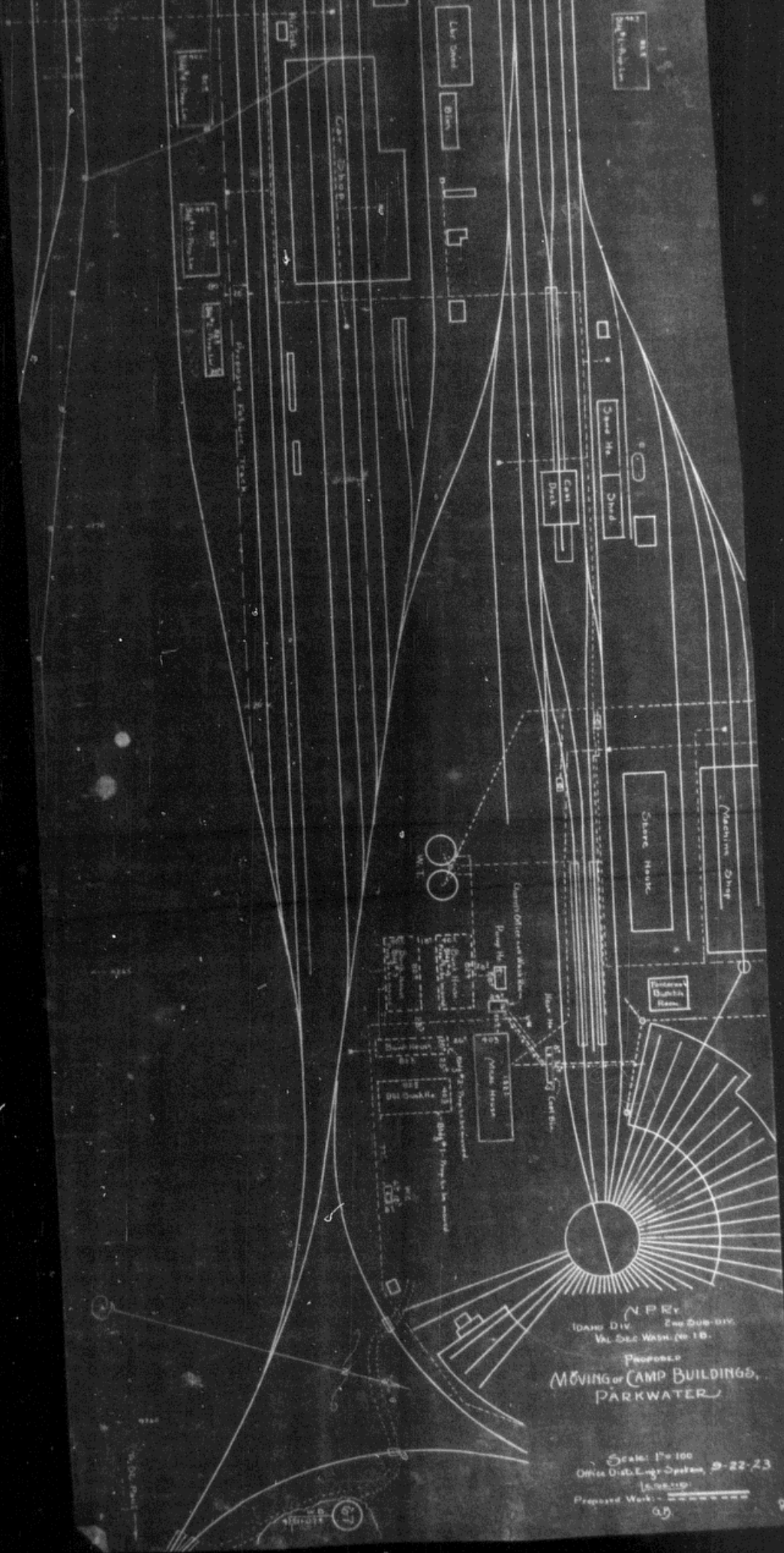
