PRE-INVENTORY INFORMATION.
GENERAL OUTLINE AND HISTORY OF THE WORK.

This section consists of a depot, water supply, certain tracks, right of way, and other facilities at Oakes which are jointly owned with the C. & N.W. Ry. Co.

The line from the north was built by the James River Valley Railroad Company in the year 1886, was called the James River Valley Railroad Extension. Part of the work of the construction, of this jointly owned section, was done by this Company and part by the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Co. (Dakota Central Ry. Co.). The grading and part of the tracklaying and surfacing on that part done by the James River Valley R.R. Co. was done by Winston Bros. under the terms of their accepted proposal of July 17th, 1886. Copies of this proposal and of the final estimates incurred under same are filed with the inventory covering the Oakes Branch, N.D. section 4A of which this line is a part.
