PRE-INVENTORY INFORMATION

GENERAL HISTORY AND OUTLINE OF THE WORK.

This is a single track branch line extending from Carbonado Junction (near Wilkeson) to Carbonado.

It was constructed in the year 1880 by the Northern Pacific Railroad Company. No records can now be found to indicate the manner of construction or of the quantities handled.

The clearing and grubbing have been very heavy. This west slope of the Cascade mountains is generally covered with a dense timber growth. Many overhanging and dangerous trees were cut outside of the regular clearing limits.

The subsidence of the roadbed will be developed at time of Government inventory.

A list of items in abandoned roadbed is included in the inventory and itemized separately.
