PRE-INVENTORY INFORMATION

GENERAL OUTLINE AND HISTORY OF THE WORK

This is a single track branch line extending from Iron River to Washburn, a port on Lake Superior.

Was built by the Washburn, Bayfield and Iron River Railway Company in the years 1897 and 1898. No record has been found to indicate manner of doing the original construction.

The line traverses a rolling timbered country for its entire length.

The subsidence of the roadbed will be developed at the time of Government Inventory.

No vouchers covering items of roadway have been found to submit.
