The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month of July:

Fargo Division locomotive No. 1166 was transferred to Lake Superior Division.

Rocky Mountain Division locomotive No. 5106 was transferred to Yellowstone Division.

Idaho Division locomotive No. 1374, which was leased Camas Prairie R. R., was returned for shopping, and the 1355 furnished in lieu thereof.

Fargo Division locomotive No. 1665, and Tacoma Division locomotives Nos. 1520 and 1621 had mechanical stokers applied while undergoing shop repairs.

New Diesel-Electric road-switch locomotive No. 155, which has been assigned to the Rocky Mountain Division, was transferred to the Tacoma Division at Auburn and assigned to Puyallup local.

New Diesel-Electric switch locomotives Nos. 162, 163 and 164 were received from the builders, the two former being assigned to Rocky Mountain Division at Missoula, and the latter to Yellowstone Division at Laurel.
