The following changes were made in assignment of locomotives during the month of January:

Rocky Mountain Division locomotive No. 1210 was authorized for dismantling and eliminated from assignment list.

Tacoma Division locomotives Nos. 1132, 1706, 1776, 1824 and 4016 were converted from coal to oil burners.

New Diesel-Electric passenger locomotives Nos. 6500, 6501, 6502, 6503, 6504 and 6505 were received from the builders and assigned to the Saint Paul Division handling Trains 1 and 2 between Saint Paul and Seattle.

New Diesel-Electric freight locomotives Nos. 6011, 6012, 6013, 6014 and 6015 were also received from the builders and assigned to the Yellowstone Division.

Total number of locomotives assigned 832.
