Convention Highlights

Registration Check-In will open Tuesday afternoon and will remain open until well into the evening. The registration table will also be open on subsequent days.

Tuesday Evening Social: The pre-convention reception with drinks and hors d'oeuvres will take place from 4:30 to 6:30 PM at Bonanzaville, located at 1351 Main Ave W, West Fargo, North Dakota. Dinner will be on your own afterward.

Bonanzaville is a pioneer village on a twelve acre site with 43 historic buildings, NP 684, 400,000 artifacts, and millions of memories. It is operated by the Cass County Historical Society, with a mission to collect, display and interpret artifacts relevant to the history and cultural heritage of the Red River Valley. It is the region's largest historical attraction with something for everyone to see.

Wednesday, Thursday & Friday: A variety of great presentations have been lined up to cover topics involving the NP's North Dakota operations, the industries they supported and other interesting Northern Pacific operations from along the their lines. Evenings will include a presentation, followed by open projector, company store and a few layout tours.

The train ride from Wahpeton to as far as Oakes, and return will be on either Thursday or Friday, as it will be determined by the railroad and its pending traffic that week. We likely will not know which day until shortly before the convention, but the train ride will definitely happen. It will cost \$95 per person which includes the train ride, bus transportation between the hotel and the train, and box lunches. This event will take up the entire day.

Saturday: The swap meet, modeling presentations, RPM meet and general membership meeting, and the no host social hour and annual convention banquet, all held at the hotel.

Spouse event: The "Fargo Street Fair" will be happening at the same time as our convention. The street fair runs on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday of that week. All of Broadway in downtown Fargo will be involved, offering tons of interesting goodies for sale, much of it at very good prices.
