Title Inspection Motor Car.

Reason: To cover purchase of second hand Model No. 3 four horse power Mudge-Adams motor car, serial number 911, from former Lineman H. Ohmneiss for use as Roadmaster's inspection car to be assigned to general Roadmaster.

This car was purchased in 1915. Ohmneiss was in military service and car was not used during 1917 and 1918, and has now been at rest since July 8th., 1922. General Roadmaster inspected it and reports it in first class condition, practically as good as new, and should last nearly as long as a new car.

To properly inspect and care for his district and Roadmaster cannot limit his travel to trains but must so cover the track that he can stop at any place that is likely to require his attention. With an inspection car this may be done at any time desired and at little expense. Without such a car this travel must be done with section crews, which takes men from their work, resulting in loss of time to crews and Roadmasters at considerable expense.
