In order to identify time freights, box car specials, stock specials, refrigerator specials and miscellaneous extra trains not provided with train numbers, the following will be used to identify these trains in the four character train number space: (some local train numbers are four digit.)

The first two characters will indicate the type of train, the second two characters will indicate the origin terminal, followed by section number and date of train. Train identification alpha characters will be punched in the "H" header card columns 3 and 4 as follows:
