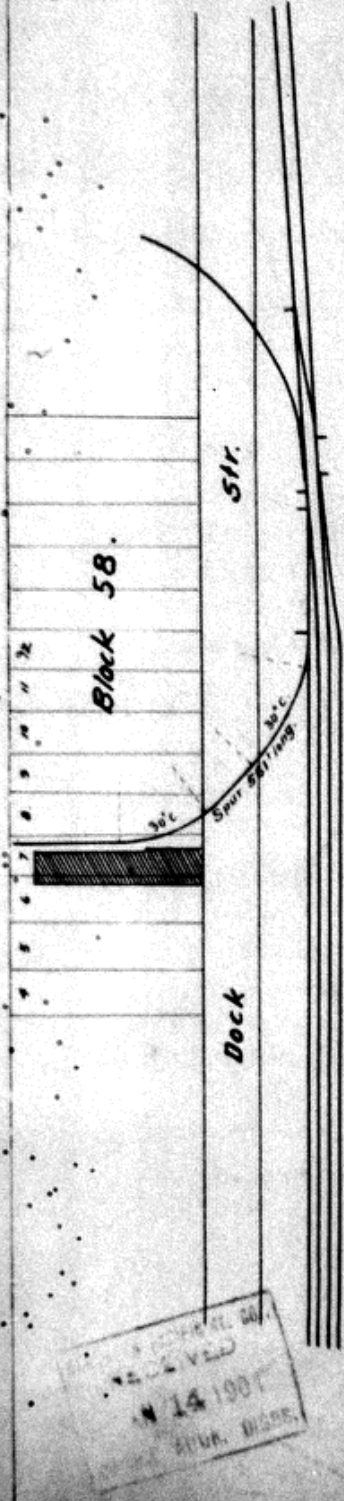


NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY
