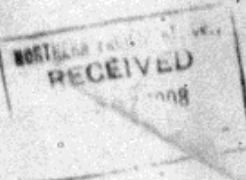

The expenditure is recommended for the following reasons:

Ice pond located about one mile and a quarter from Sappington station, on Pony and Morris Branch, and Jefferson river, as per sketch attached. Work is all completed.

Ice pond involves about six acres of water, sufficient for cutting ice.

Contract executed with Mr. H. H. Sappington for term of ten years, with exclusive right to cut ice at rate of 50¢ per car, and easement covering all ground for track and ice-loading chute, trestles, and any other structures that is necessary for handling ice crop.

In making the channel change the C M & St P Ry. was required to provide culverts under its line to serve irrigation ditches which were fed from the portion of the river cut off by the change. This formed a pond of live water, which being located in a district where the winters are uniformly cold, makes a very reliable ice pond. It is thought that two crops of ice can be cut from the pond without fail each year, and probably three. It seemed desirable to secure the rights to this ice pond in advance of the C M & St P Ry. We are short of places for securing ice supply in Montana.
