Title **Heavy Repairs and Partial Replacement of the joint and Northern Pacific-Western Union Telegraph Pole Line.**
Reason:

This line was last reconstructed in 1900 with class "B" Eastern Cedar poles, set 30 per mile. A recent inspection of this line by representatives of the Railway and Telegraph Company indicates that approximately 35% of the poles are defective and need repairs or replacing. It was agreed by the representatives of the two companies that the work should consist of resetting of defective poles, which would provide sufficient clearance; replacement or stubbing of other defective poles; setting deeper such poles as have heaved in swamps; the addition of side guys to stiffen the line in swamps; and replacement of other defective material. New poles to be class "C" Western Cedar tank treated.
