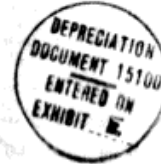

Title Assessment for sanitary sewers in Main and other streets.

Reason: This RFA is made to cover an assessment levied against our right of way as its proportion of the cost of constructing sanitary sewers in main and other streets. Blue print attached shows sewers built in Main street directly affecting this company and our frontage assessed. The total cost of this improvement was \$14,030.69, all of which was assessed by the special assessment commission against the property it deemed benefited in accordance with its judgment as to benefits received. The assessment against our right of way has been checked at Jamestown and found to have been made on the same basis that other property is assessed, and is correct.
