Title **Moving and converting old pump house into an ice house.**

Reason: We have a small ice house for serving the station and section forces at Wilbur but this building has been in use a great many years and has become in an extremely dilapidated condition. We also have at that point an old abandoned pump house which is not needed. This building is 12x30' in dimension and may be moved and fitted up satisfactorily for an ice house, this job involving moving the building a short distance to the house track, putting under it new sills, placing the door on the rear side and closing up the front doors and windows.

It is important that we have facilities for storing seasons ice supply at Wilbur for the station and section men to avoid the necessity for shipping ice on passenger trains at frequent intervals and under excessive shrinkage during the summer months.

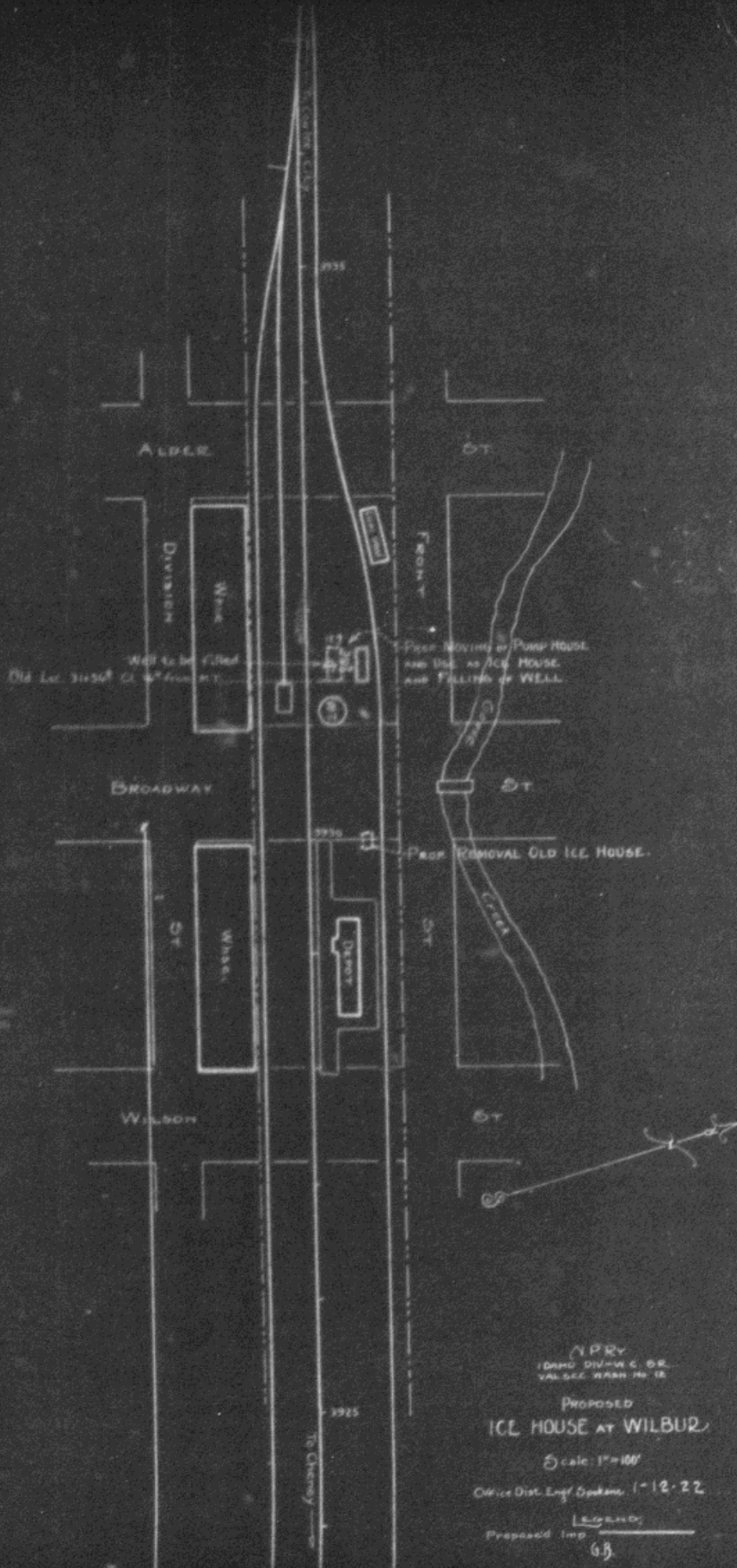
