Reason:

In 1920 a heavy assessment was levied by the City of Seattle for street improvements against the old Shore Line right of way lying north of Plummer Street, and the Railway Company concluded not to pay the assessment but sell the right of way to the abutting owners at the best prices obtainable. Most of this right of way has been sold and this A.F.E. will dispose of the balance of the right of way on this line with the exception of one small piece. Our title to the tract sold is claimed by adverse possession only. So far as our records show nothing was paid for the property and the purchase price of \$500.00 should be credited to Profit and Loss.

Deed conveying the property to **J. F. Carrier** was signed by **Mr. Donnelly** September 29, 1922.
