Title Reason: At present the wheel platform at Como Shops is in Such condition that it must be given immediate attention either through replacing in kind or with a new platform of more substantial material. This platform is used for the storing and handling of heavy car wheels and consists of fir plank. The average life of this plank is about three years although some of it fails in a much shorter time. It is estimated that if we use crecsoted treated blocks on a six inch concrete base, we can get better than 12 or 14 year life out of the platform. Oak, unless it is treated, would fail before that time through rot and it is threfore proposed to use treated material, the blocks to be made from material either from second hand timber removed from cars or from new scrap material obtainable at the Car Shop, which, after being cut up, will be forwarded to Brainerd Tie Treating Plant for treatment. The annual cost of the present fir platform considering an average of three years is \$318.00, while the average life of the proposed treated block platform is estimated at \$240.00, resulting in a net saving of \$78.00 per year.
