

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 2. Bridge and Engine restrictions—NP engines heavier than class W-3 not permitted.
- 3. At Bremerton Jct. and N.A.D. Jct., normal position of Junction switch is for Shelton-Bangor Line.
- 4. Between Shelton and Bay Shore, there are two groups of three grade crossings each of the Simpson Logging Co. Railroad located 200 feet and 1600 feet east of connection with N. P. Main track at Shelton. All trains must stop before passing over these crossings. If trains arrive simultaneously on both lines, trains of the Simpson Logging Co. must be given preference.
- 5. Bulletin stations—Bangor.
- 6. Standard clock—Bangor.
- 8. At Bayshore—No. 1 track used as siding.
- 9. Register stations—Shelton, Bremerton Jct., Bremerton, N.A.D. Jct., Bangor.
