SPECIAL RULES.

- 1. Full-faced figures indicate meeting and passing points.
- 2. East bound trains will have ABSOLUTE right to track over west bound trains of same or inferior class.
- 3. All engine and train crews will be subject to Northern Pacific rules and regulations while in Pasco yard.
- 4. Switches at Junction of N. P. and W. & C. R. tracks 1 and 2 miles east of Hunt's Jct. will be left set and locked for N. P. line. Switch at Killian Jct. will be left set and locked for Pendleton line. Switch at Eureka Jct. will be left set and locked for Walla Walla line.
- 5. Trains going in either direction must be kept under full control between the Junction switches and depot at Hunt's Jct.
- 6. Speed of trains must not exceed 6 miles an hour within the corporate limits of the cities of Pendleton, Walla Walla and Dayton.
- 7. All trains will come to a full stop before crossing the O. R. & N. track at Pendleton, between Penitentiary and Walla Walla, between Huntsville and Longs, and before crossing Snake River Valley track on Pasco-Wallula line and on Wye connection 2 miles east of Hunt's Jct., and before crossing draw Snake River Bridge.
- 8. All trains and light engines will register at Pasco Jct., Hunt's Jct., Killian Jct., Athena, Pendleton, Eureka Jct., Walla Walla and Dayton. Nos. 1 and 2 will register at East Wye switch.
 - 9. No. 11 will have right of track over No. 12, Killian Jct. to Athena.
 - 10. No. 9 has right of track over No. 10, Eureka Jct. to Pleasant View.
 - 11. No. 13 will have right of track over No. 14, Walla Walla to Tracy.

NOTE.

NOTE—Surgeons will attend when called upon officially, to all cases of accident occurring to employes or passengers. In cases of sickness it is the intention to limit medical service to the locality or town where a surgeon resides; unless some urgent necessity exists, for which distinct official authority must be had in accordance with established regulations.

NOTE—Railway Officials are required to call on the nearest authorized surgeons whenever practicable, when surgical or medical services are needed. When such are accessible, the association will not be responsible for bills for medical services rendered by any other physician. In the event of a sudden emergency, arising from accident, if necessary proper surgical aid should be procured until the arrival of a regularly appointed surgeon, when the case should be placed in his charge and in no case should the services of any but an authorized company surgeon be continued at the expense of the Railway Company or of the Association after such surgeon is able to assume charge of the case.

NOTE—Boarding and Nursing are furnished only at our own hospitals. We are not responsible for bills incurred elsewhere unless specially authorized or approved by the Chief Surgeon and then only in critical cases of injury occurring in discharge of duty.
