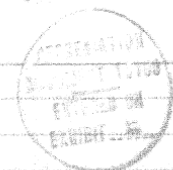

Reason:

Minnesota Grade Crossing law, Chapter 336, Session Laws of 1925, approved April 24th, 1925, provides that certain Highway Crossings of Railroads at grade shall be "Stop" crossings.
