Title HEAVY REPAIRS & RECONSTRUCTION OF TELEGRAPH LINE.

Reason: This jointly owned Northern Pacific-Western Union line was last entirely reconstructed in 1914 with 25-ft. class "A" Eastern Cedar poles set 41 to the mile. The line is gained for 5 crossarms and carries 27 telegraph and telephone wires on three 10-ft. 10-pin arms attached in the first, second and third gains. One additional wire is attached on brackets opposite the fourth gain.

An exclusive Northern Pacific 10-ft. 10-pin signal cross-arm carrying the automatic signal wires is located in the fifth gain.

The line was storm-guyed with Never-Creep anchors in 1923.
