Title: **Heavy Repairs & Reconstruction of Telegraph Line.**

Reason: **PRESENT**

This joint line was last reconstructed in 1915 with Class "B" 25-ft. Western Cedar poles for the body of the line, spaced 40 to 41 poles per mile.

The line was given heavy repairs in 1924. At that time 237 poles were replaced with class "B" Western Cedar butt-tank-treated poles; 26 pole braces were replaced with guys and anchors, 24 anchors and guys were added. The poles are gained for four crossarms.

Between Laurel Depot and Rocky Fork Junction the poles are equipped with four 10-ft. 10-pin crossarms, located in the first, second, third and fourth gains; the signal arm occupies the fifth gain.
