This telegraph line was totally reconstructed in 1898 with class "C" Eastern Cedar, 25-ft. poles, spaced 30 poles per mile.

Between Helena and 4278 ft. west of Blossburg the line was totally reconstructed in 1918 with class "B" Western Cedar poles, the spacing being 41 per mile. During this same year the section between 4278 ft. west of Blossburg and Garrison was given heavy repairs.

There are attached in the first named section three 10-ft. 10-pin telegraph crossarms and one 10-ft. signal crossarm; and in the second section there are attached two 10-ft. 10-pin, two 8-ft. 6-pin telegraph crossarms, and one 10-ft. signal crossarm.
