The location is between Arrow, Oro Fino and Stites, Idaho. on this company's property.

Location: HEAVY REPAIRS & RECONSTRUCTION OF POLE LINE.  
Title: Present

Reason: This is an exclusive Northern Pacific pole line. The line between Arrow and Mile Post 18 was constructed in 1899; between Mile Post 18 and Kooskia in 1900; and between Kooskia and Stites in 1902, with class "C" Idaho Cedar 25-ft. poles for the body of the line.

The entire line was partly reconstructed in 1923 and 1924 with class "D" Western Cedar brush treated poles. 17 new poles were added at this time.

Between Arrow and Kooskia the crossarms were originally 6-ft. 4-pin, but in 1924 there were 433 crossarms replaced with pole brackets. The line between Kooskia and Stites is a bracket line.
