Reason:

Budget Item No. 303 refers to the installation of a "Teletype" set in the St. Paul General Office and at the time the budget was being prepared it was the idea that the installation was largely for experimental purposes. Since then, however, a circuit between St. Paul and Staples was equipped with Teletype sets and their performance was satisfactory.

It is now desired to purchase two sets of this kind of equipment, one for Seattle and one for Tacoma. They will serve to expedite the handling of telegraph business between these two points and will probably result in a decrease of force at certain times of the year, or delay the need for an increase in times of heavy business
