Reason:

Effective with the operation of pool trains 458-459 and 563 and 564 via Longview it was necessary to have continuous telegraph service at Olegus in order to handle the movement of trains to and from IP&N tracks. Heretofore, Agent-Operator only was maintained at Olegus and he occupied the agent's house. As other living quarters are not available and, as the section headquarters were discontinued some time ago, the vacant section house is used to take care of the additional operators. The occupants of the living quarters will pay for the current used by them. Electric lights are requested in order to reduce the fire hazard and also to improve living conditions, as Olegus is not a very satisfactory place at which to live.
