Reason:

The Hercules Mill at Wallace places their order for empties with the agent to alternate box cars and gondolas. In loading out their ore, if they find they cannot use cars alternately as set in, they let the particular car they cannot use go by, with result that the empties are mixed in with the loads, making additional switching to get them out. To do away with this, an additional track was constructed as per blue print attached, so that the empties they let by could be dropped in on this track, saving considerable time to the switch crew each day.

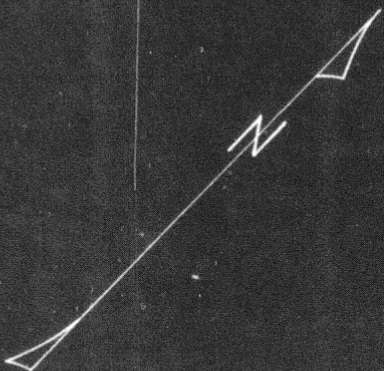
