Title: Replace Crossing Bells with Wigwag

The County highway crossing, at East Auburn, is now protected by crossing bells which are of an obsolete type and, inasmuch as there is considerable traffic over this paved highway crossing, including busses handling school children into Auburn and return, standard crossing protection should be provided. Various Bureaus and A.A.A.Clubs, also the Interstate Commerce Commission and State Authorities, call attention to the fact that many accidents are due to lack of uniformity in crossing protection.

We have had no serious accidents at this crossing as yet, but during foggy weather, of which we have considerable in this territory, this crossing is extremely dangerous, being on a 3-degree curve, especially in view of the fact that westbound trains pass over it at a high rate of speed. The view is limited to 800 feet to eastbound trains, but a good view with no obstructions is had of westbound trains, except in foggy weather.

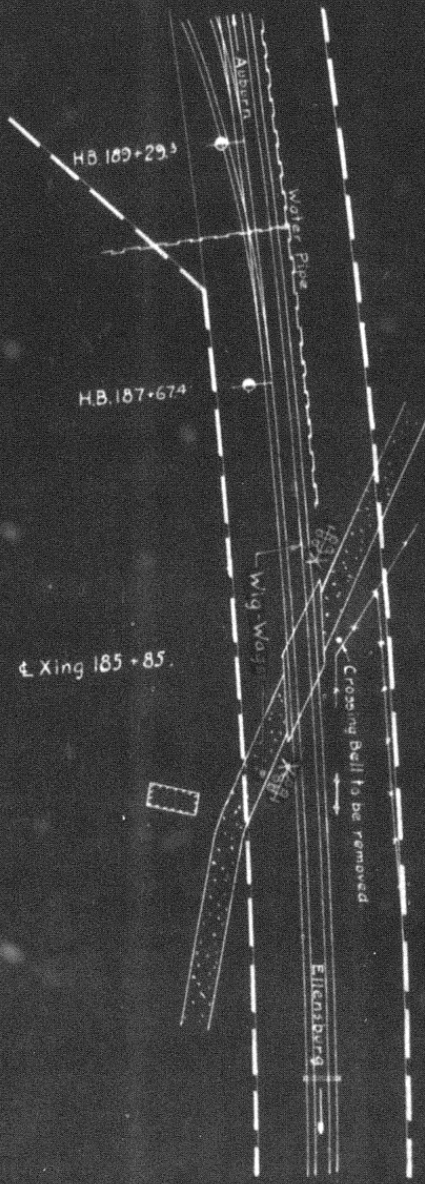
