Reason:

This jointly owned Northern Pacific-Western Union pole line was constructed in 1887 with Class "C" Eastern Cedar 25-ft. poles in the body of the line. The poles are galvanized for one crossarm and set 30 per mile, and carry one No. 8 and one No. 9 iron wire, attached on brackets for the entire distance. These two wires are owned by the Railway Company.

The line has received no other repairs, except such as have been made by the lineman under day to day maintenance.

A recent inspection shows that 62% of the poles are defective so as to require replacement or resetting.
