PRE-INVENTORY INFORMATION:  
GENERAL OUTLINE AND HISTORY OF THE WORK.

This is a single track branch line extending from Manhattan to Anceney.

Was constructed by the Camp Creek Railway Company in the year 1911.

The general work of grading and laying of culvert pipe was done by Foley Brothers and Stewart under their contract of June 19th, 1911.

The tracklaying and surfacing was done by the Railway Company with its own forces.

The general work of fencing was done by Logan Whitacre under his contract of July 12th, 1911.

The general work of building timber bridges was done by George Cook and Sons under their contract of August 23rd, 1911.

Copies of all the final estimate vouchers which have been found covering roadway work are submitted with the inventory.

The subsidence of the roadbed will be developed at the time of Government inventory.

This line lies entirely in the Gallatin Valley. This is a highly developed irrigated country and considerable work has been required to care for the numerous ditches.
