GENERAL OUTLINE AND HISTORY OF THE WORK

This single track line was built by the Northern Pacific Railway Company in the months of August and September, 1910. Was built by the Railway Company with its own forces. This was part of the plan for the building of a line from Edgeley to the Missouri River, which was not carried out at that time and is now held in abeyance. The track is now used as a spur and a storage track.
