PRE-INVENTORY INFORMATION.
GENERAL OUTLINE AND HISTORY OF THE WORK.

This is a single track branch line running from Belmont to Farmington.

Was constructed by the Spokane and Palouse Railway Company in the year 1890. The general work of grading, building bridges and culverts, tracklaying and surfacing and erection of buildings was done by Donald Smith and Howell under the terms of their accepted proposal of August 12th, 1890.

The ballast is composed of cinders coming from Belmont.

The subsidence of the roadbed will be developed at time of Government inventory.

Copies of all the final estimate vouchers which have been found covering roadway work are submitted with the inventory.
