

CONDUCTOR'S REPORT OF EJECTION FROM TRAIN

RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

When a passenger is ejected from a train for any cause, the conductor shall make immediate wire report giving full details to Superintendent and Chief Special Agent.

The conductor is authorized to eject any person from his train who boards same without proper transportation and who refuses to pay fare.

The conductor may eject any person from train for committing a crime thereon, or any other unlawful act, and such person when ejected shall be turned over to an officer of the law, whose name and address shall be obtained.

THE CONDUCTOR SHALL OBTAIN NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF ALL WITNESSES TO PASSENGER EJECTION AND EVENTS LEADING THERETO, AND INSERT THESE NAMES AND ADDRESSES IN SPACE PROVIDED IN THIS REPORT.

No person shall be ejected from train until it has been brought to a full stop. A person shall not be ejected except at stop where shelter and food is obtainable. Infirm person ejected from train shall be placed in charge of person who shall be directed to assist him, without expense to the company, in obtaining care that such person may require. Badly intoxicated person shall be turned over to a police officer or other person, who shall be directed to see that such person is kept in clear of railway property to avoid hazard of injury.

In ejecting passenger, use no more force than is necessary, endeavor to avoid infliction of personal injuries, and avoid use of abusive and insulting language.
