

# DAILY COMMODITY REPORT TELEGRAPH SERVICE

Agents wire this report for their stations as instructed DAILY with "CS" report. No reports should be made for Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays but loading for these days must be included in report for following day. Agents must include all cars loaded at their stations, cars loaded at spurs and blind sidings for which they make waybills, all loads received from connecting lines (except loads handled on a switching rate) and all class of cars terminated at their stations. (See instructions on reverse side).

NOTE: When wiring, please send in the following order: Cars originating on system, Section A class of cars loaded on system, Section C, Section D, Cars received from connection and Section B Class of cars terminated on system. The numbers appearing to the left of the commodity column are for Home Office use only.

## INSTRUCTIONS

#### SECTION (A)-CARS LOADED

- 1. Report total number of cars loaded on system by types and separate between Railroad cars (W), Private cars (X) and Company freight (Y). Cars loaded with empty system trailers or containers should be included in total cars loaded.
- 2. Cars loaded in switching service by any connecting line railroad that are billed and hauled by the N. P. Railroad are to be included in class of cars loaded.
- 3. Cars loaded for inter-terminal or intra-terminal switch-move only on system are to be included in Class of cars loaded.

## SECTION (B)-CARS TERMINATED

- Report total number of cars terminated on system by types and separate between Railroad cars (W), Private cars (X) and Company freight (Y). Cars from which empty trailers and containers are unloaded should be included in total cars terminated.
- 2. Cars delivered to a connecting line railroad in switching service to be unloaded which the N. P. Railroad handled as final road-haul carrier are to be included in class of cars terminated.
- 3. Cars received loaded from a connecting line for switch delivery should not be reported.
- 4. Loaded cars for intra-terminal or inter-terminal switch move originating on N. P. Railroad should be included in Class of Cars Terminated.

#### SECTION (C)

- 1. Report all cars loaded with trailers or containers, loaded or empty, revenue (W) and non-revenue (X).
- 2. Report all cars loaded with trailers or containers which are loaded with mail or express revenue and handled on Passengers Train (Y) or on Freight Trains (Z).
- 3. Cars reported in (W) or (X) must be included and normally will agree with total reported in Section A, Line 18.
- 4. Cars reported in (Y) or (Z), mail or express, are not included in Section A, Line 18.
- 5. A car loaded with one trailer or container of freight and one trailer or container of mail or express should be reported under (W).

## SECTION (D)

This section covers the number of trailers or containers that are loaded on cars reported in Section C.

Plan 1. Trailers or containers leased or supplied by truckers (non on joint rail motor rates).

Plan 2. Trailers or containers leased or supplied by railroads (moving on railroad tariff rates, but not on joint rail motor rates).

Plan 2½. Trailers or containers leased or supplied by railroads (where the railroad performs only ramp to ramp service).

Plan 3. Trailers or containers leased or supplied by shipper (moved on cars furnished by railroad).

Plan 4. Trailers or containers leased or supplied by shipper (moved on cars also furnished by shipper).

Plan 5. All trailers or containers moving on joint rail motor rates.

Plan 6. Railroad trailers substituted for box cars-loaded with LCL (not moving on piggy back tariff rates).

Plan 7. Railroad trailers substituted for box cars-carload or equal to trailer load (not moving on piggy back tariff rates).

Plan 8. All trailers or containers loaded with mail, moved in freight train at mail contract rates.

Plan 8-A. All trailers or containers loaded with mail, moved in passenger train at either ICC or contract rates.

Plan 9. All trailers or containers loaded with express moved in freight trains.

Plan 9-A. All trailers or containers loaded with express moved in passenger trains.
