INSTRUCTIONS.

Agents at Junction points where foreign cars are received, will furnish Conductors with "Foreign Car Route Card" properly filled out, for each foreign car received; which must accompany car each time it is moved whether loaded or empty until delivered off line and Conductors will refuse to move such cars unless provided with these cards, except from non-agency stations or on order from Superintendent.

When set out, card accompanying car must be delivered to Agent, or if non agency station, card must be delivered to nearest Agent beyond, who will ascertain in which direction car will move next, and take steps to get car and card to gether without unnecessary delay.

If delivered to Connecting Lines at point other than that at which received, Agent at delivering Junction will enter road and date delivered and hold route cards until cars are returned to this line, then enter road and date received and forward card with car. If cars delivered Connecting Lines are not returned in 30 days ask this office by mail for disposition of cards.

When left at non-agency stations Conductors will so note on back of card giving name of station and date.

If card is lost make new one obtaining information from Superintendent's office.
