KEEP THE LIGHTS AND HANDLES AWAY FROM THE CABOOS AND FIRE STATION

1. This car, if a tank car, must be not less than 5 cars from engine and 5 cars from caboose; or near center of train.
2. This car must not be next to car containing explosives or charcoal or cotton. Hold next car protected by strong ladder position of this car in yard before cutting loose and let preceding one clear.
3. Yardmasters and employees must note position of this car in yard and be prepared to isolate it quickly in case of fire.
4. Test brakes on hump. Hold next car protected by strong ladder position of this car in yard before cutting loose and let preceding one clear.
5. Watch this and adjacent cars for broken packages, leaking liquid, place diamond carefully on isolated siding, if necessary, and wire remove damaged labels.
6. Sweep up and clear diamond yellow labels.
7. For packages protected by strong ladder position of this car in yard before cutting loose and let preceding one clear.
8. WHEN INFLAMMABLE PACKAGES ARE ALL UNLOADED, AGENTS, YARDMASTERS AND CONDUCTORS MUST REMOVE AND PLACE AWAY FROM THE CAR.
