SIGNATURE OF USER OF PASS

Not good for transportation without the accompanying pass and to be honored only in the territory covered by the pass.

Not good for stop-over between points named.

Conductor will turn this in with his trip pass collections.

RULES

This identification card properly filled out and signed by the Superintendent, Roadmaster, Foreman, or other official, must be given to any person to whom a pass is furnished that is stamped, "Not Good unless accompanied by Identification Card, Form No. 1913."

Parties issuing these cards will have them signed in their presence by the person who is to use the pass. As an identification, Conductor must require holder of pass to again sign his name on blank line below when pass is presented. A separate card must be issued for each trip. Draw a line through the words "and.....(.....) men" when pass is to be used by only one person. Cards should be properly filled out.
